



It is to certify, that Izodom 2000 Polska Sp. z o.o. is the winner of GreenEvo Green Technology Accelerator Program organized by Polish Ministry of Environment, since 2012.

It is the first construction technology awarded the title. The program aims to identify and promote Polish green technologies, that fulfill requirements of sustainable development principles.

Izodom and its technology was verified by a group of experts and the title was granted for "the Company's own construction technology dedicated for energy saving and passive houses, based on the principle of application of permanent, insulating formwork system". The energy savings in housing, can be observed as minimalisation of energy resources consumed for cooling and air conditioning in hot zones, as well as for heating in cold zones.

Since 2012 Izodom has been promoted by Polish Ministry of Environment and thus by the Polish Government in number of countries such as: Chile, Iran, Russia, Georgia, Croatia, France, Algeria, Kazakhstan and many others. The Company representatives also took part in delegations of Polish Prime Minister Mr. Donald Tusk to Nigeria, Zambia and The Republic of South Africa in 2013-2014.

Up to now, there are over 70 companies in the GreenEvo program, which offer a variety of green technologies for sustainable development, including renewable sources of energy, wastewater treatment plants and drinking water treatment plants, lighting systems and solutions for the waste management sector.

GreenEvo awards only Polish, green technologies offered by companies with experience and references in international markets. All technologies must be patented and certified.
